**Data Protection** 

Backup configurations can be set to run periodically, typically on a daily

scheduled bas's t'rough our software agent ("Agent"). When a backup

configure tion is running, only changes to files and databases you have

selecte for backup on the computer are captured by our Agent and

immediately gueued for transmission to our servers. It is critical that the

computer(s) from which you choose to opt for a backup job has a stable

Internet connection to facilitate the necessary data transfer for successful

backups. You are expected to review the log content of every backup

execution to make sure that the backups have taken place successfully. The Agent provides various means for communication of the backup status including desktop notification, email notification with various information level options.

## **Historical Data Protection**

After the initial backup of a computer has been completed a been backups of the same data (files/backup jobs) on such computers would be versioned up to a maximum of 10 historical varrions. This means that the first backup performed is a complete full backup and the subsequent backup of the file(s)/backup sets would be increasental and versioned thereby facilitating retrieval of previous regions of the file(s)/backup sets.

## For IBackup accounts of rated prior to 10th August 2011:

After the initial brokup of a computer is completed, your data on the computer is archived to another storage device at least once a day, using 'Srapshots' Technology. Currently, the number of such Snapshots is fixed at 10. In other words, a user will be able to access and restore from any of the previous 10 daily Snapshots. The Snapshot count may change without notice.

## **Internet-Based Restore**

Restore time over the network is limited by your connection bandwidth speed and quality and may reach speeds of approximately 1.5 Mbps. At speeds faster than 1.5 Mbps, other factors may limit network restore times.

Network performance, data compressibility and end user systems affect restore times.

## The Service

To use the Service you should download and install the designated Agent from our website to each computer you wish to backup your Data. Once configure it and launched, the Agent replicates and synchronizes the selected Data it is an antirety (the "Initial Backup") to one of our offsite data storage backup servers. After the initial backup, only changes to files and databases selected for backup on the computer are sent to the backup servers.

You manage the Service through a client interface within the Agent that is personalized with your custom content. This is the only interface provided with the Service. You can optionally provide a user-defined private encryption key during your first (i) install of the Agent or (ii) access through our website, which you would be expected to archive in a safe place. The will not be able to retrieve your computer data correctly without without with this encryption passphrase on a new computer when you remains the encryption passphrase as the Service assumes no liability for the loss of your user-defined encryption passphrase leading to non-retrieval of your computer data by the Agent.
